1) TBC semester tuition base rate. Includes: 12 to 19 credit hours, two-week academic excursion, airport pickup/drop-off, 24-hour on-site program support, orientation in Beijing (activities, most meals, speakers), individual Chinese language tutor, day trips in and around Beijing, initial meal stipend.
